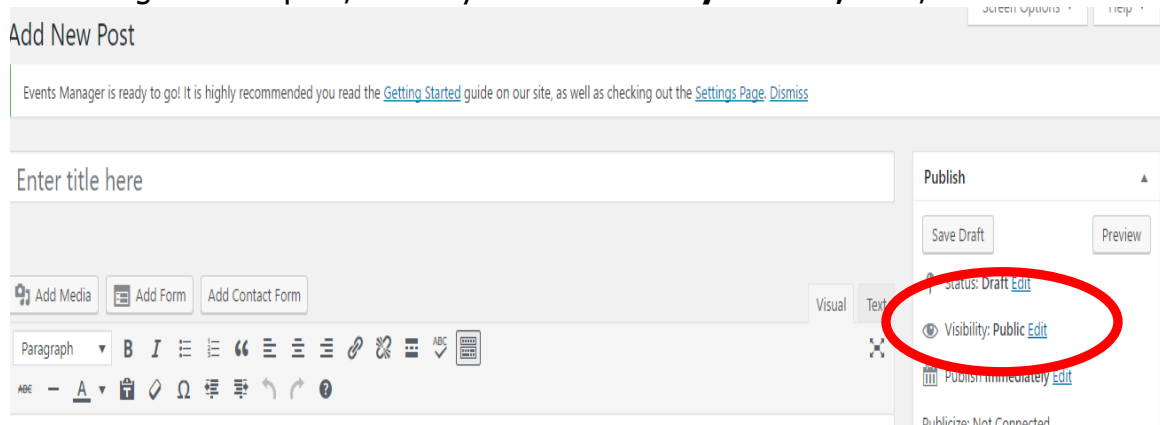
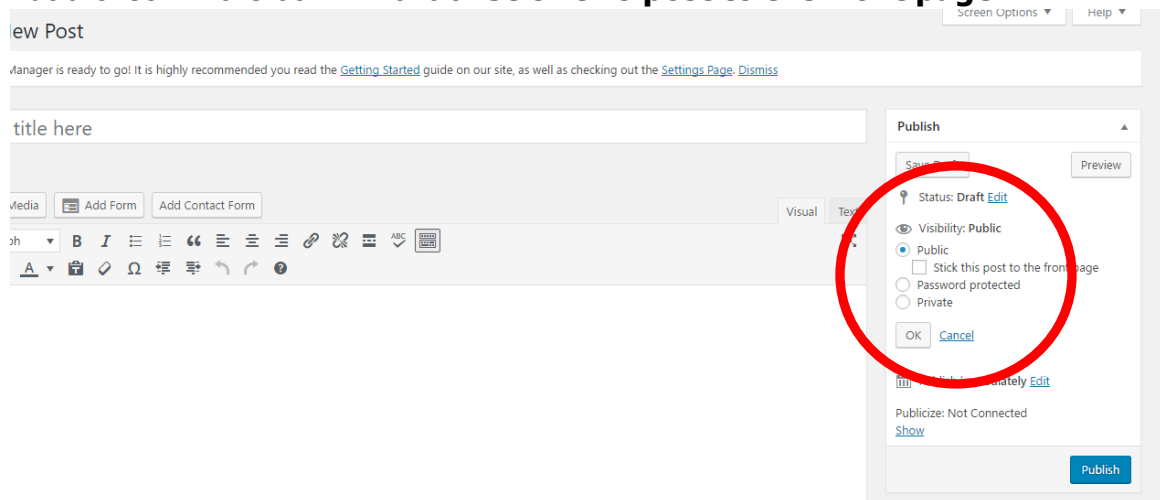


How to make a Sticky Post in WordPress. A post that will stay at the **top** of your website. A single click will do the trick!

1. Create your post as normal
2. On the right of the post, where you see **Visibility: Public, Edit**, click **Edit**



3. Put a check in the box in front of **Stick this post to the front page.**



4. Click **OK**.
5. Click **Publish**. The post you were working on, will be at the top of your website as you post other posts. When you want the post to come down, or not be at the top of your website, simply uncheck the box, click publish or update, or delete the post altogether.

**NOTE:** An example when you might use this, is your Summer Reading registration form.

In this example, the Summer Reading... post is a sticky post, or at the top of the website above all other posts.
