To make projects in a workable size, rotate the image and increase the zoom 138% on your color photocopier. Use cardstock to make your Cubee Creatures.

You will need sharp scissors and an X-Acto knife to cut out your character. You may need double-stick tape or glue stick to complete your project.

The following Cubee characters have been increased to an 8.5 x 11 sheet of paper and are ready for you to print and share:

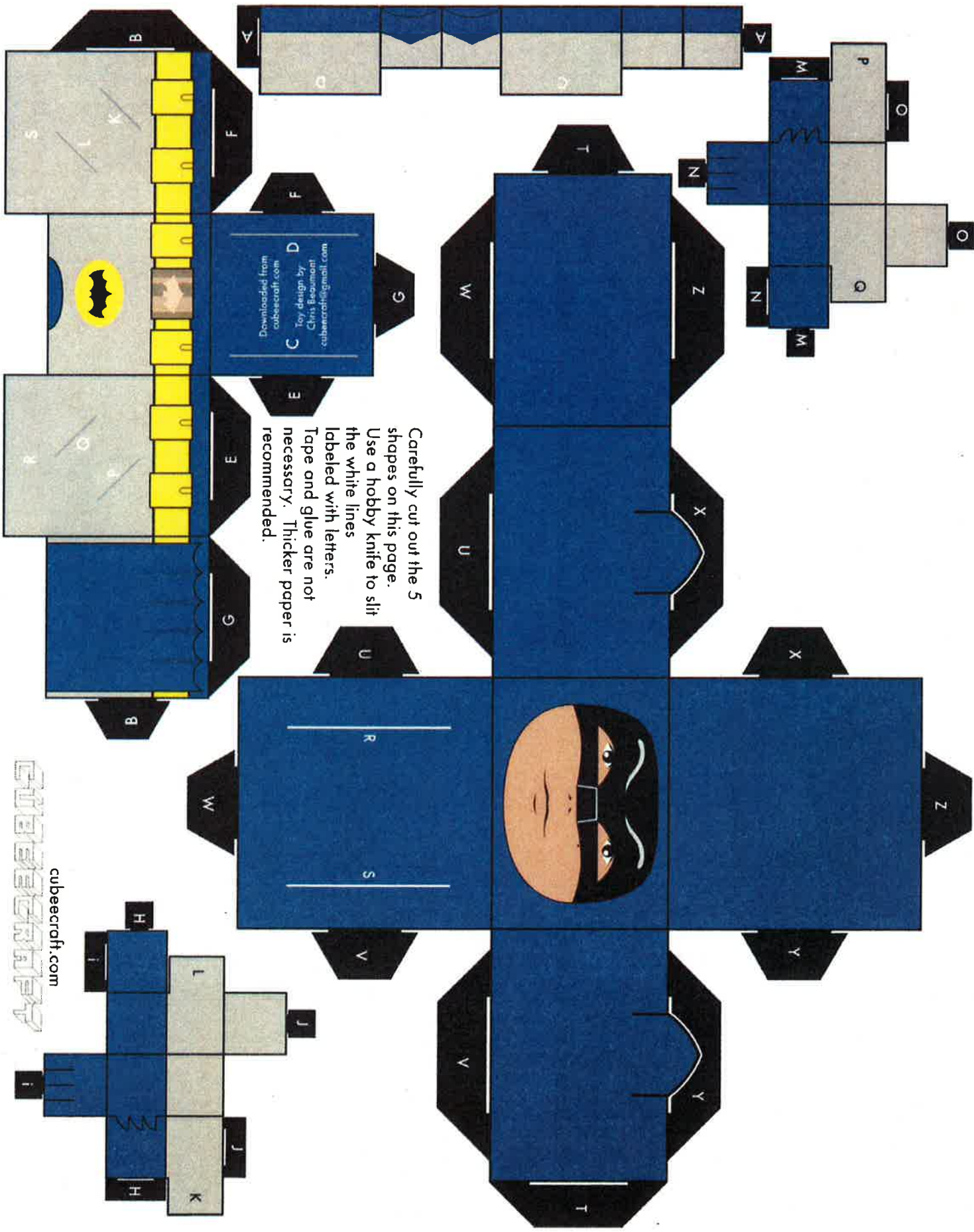

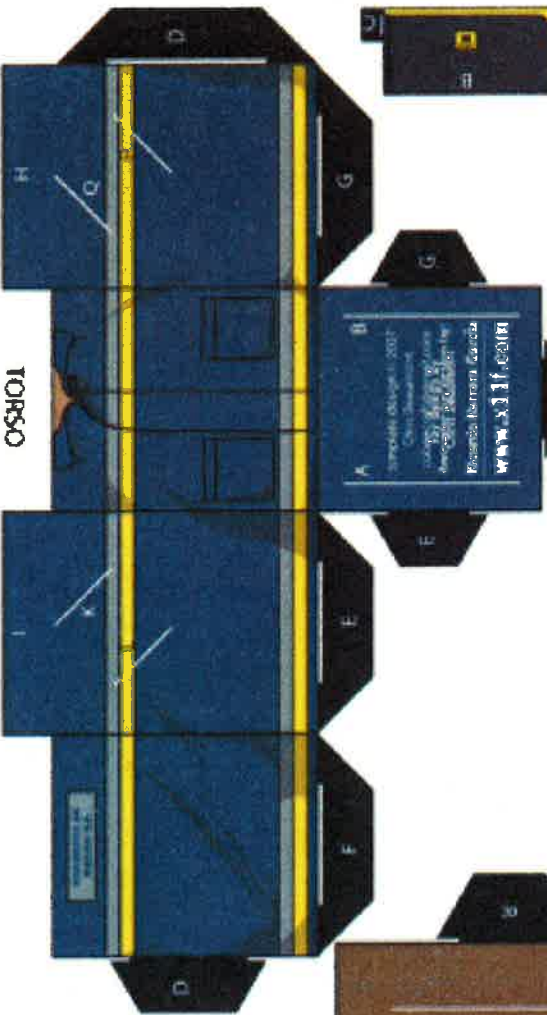
RIGHT ARM



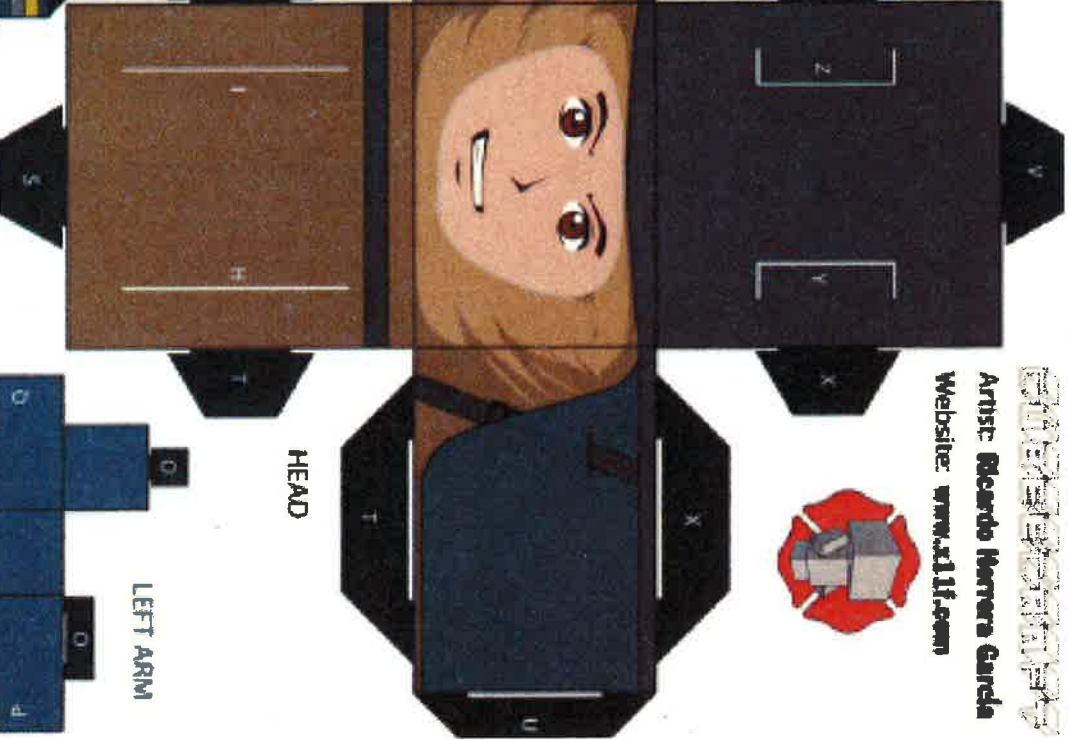
LEGS



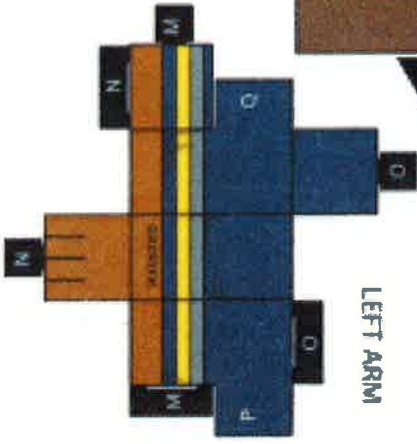
TORSO

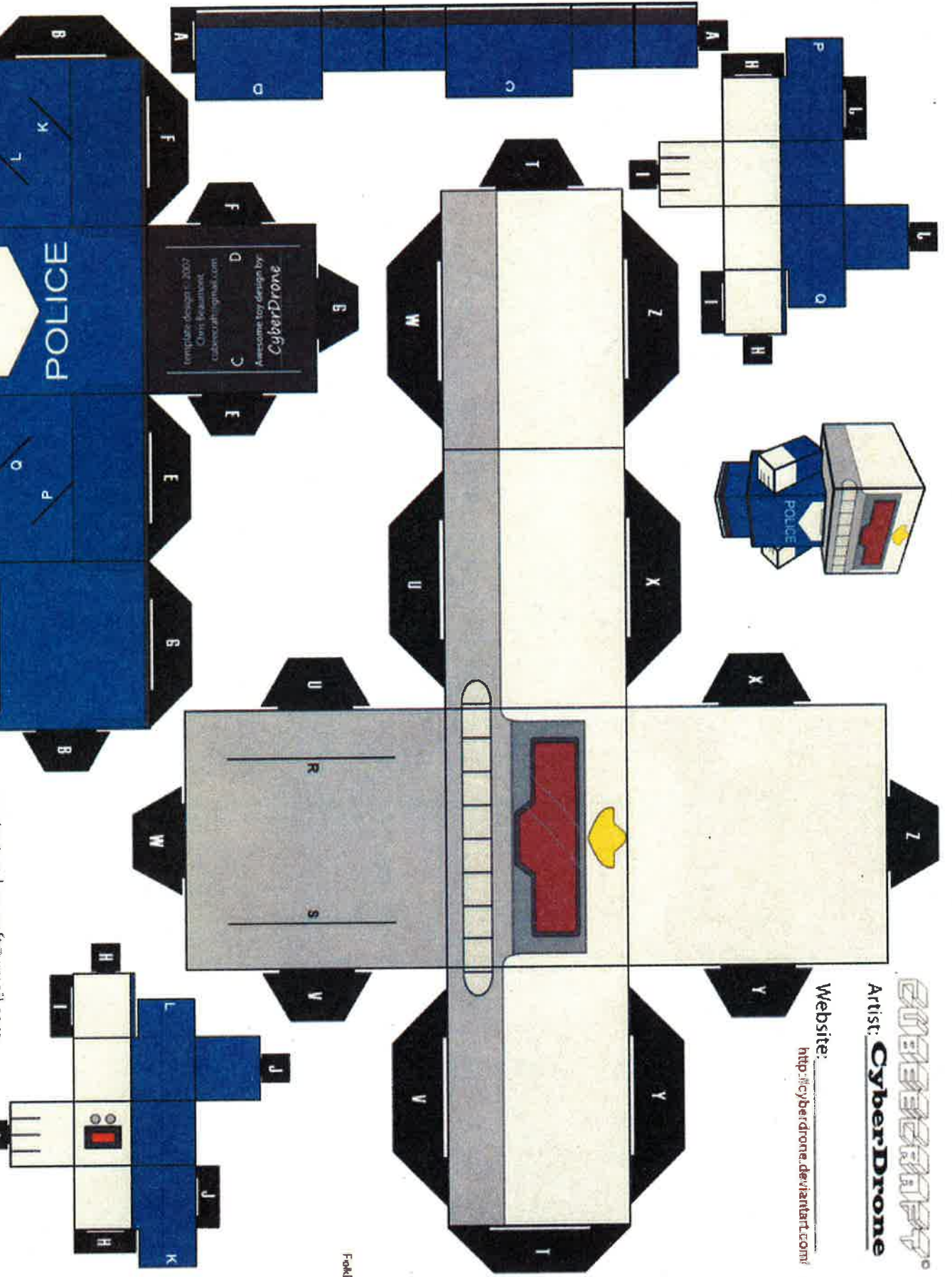
