


## General Use Using CloudLibrary

You will need to install an app or open the cloudLibrary website to use this service. A Kansas Library eCard is required for access.

1. **Find the app for your device** or search your app store for cloudLibrary (\*the Kindle Fire app is only available on the cloudLibrary website)
2. Set up the app by selecting the **State Library of Kansas**
3. You will need to know your **library card number** and **PIN** (cards will expire after 3 years) - Your PIN will be your birthdate in MMDDYYYY format. Need your card number? [Click here](#).
4. Browse or search for content, check out available titles, place holds, and save titles for later.
5. Be sure your eBook or audiobook downloads completely before leaving network or wi-fi coverage

\*Note - audiobooks cannot be transferred to a device or played back offline with the desktop software. Devices must be able to install the cloudLibrary app to use audiobooks.
